

# PHOTOSHOP SHORTCUTS



Use keyboard shortcuts to be more productive while using Adobe Photoshop. You can also customize keyboard shortcuts if you prefer something different from the default. To do this in Photoshop, select Edit > Keyboard Shortcuts. Most of the following shortcuts are from Adobe's website, and were last updated June 6, 2017.
